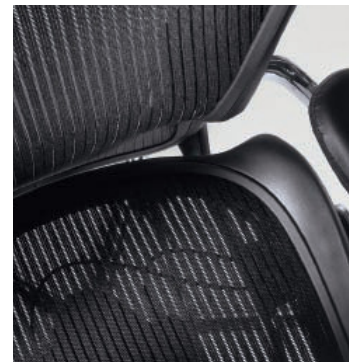

Versatile Looks

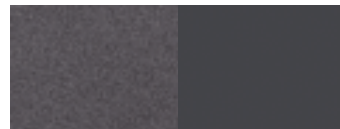

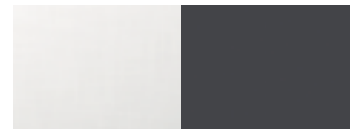
Titanium Base *Smoke Frame*
